Department of International Relations , Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, Universitas Gadjah Mada founded the International Undergraduate Program (IUP) with the aim of producing graduates equipped with excellent academic competence and the necessary skills to fill the growing needs and intensity of global engagements.

The expected outcome is not for the graduates to merely be the members of a global society, but also for them to inspire and bring about changes to the existing political, economic, and social conditions, and lead their transformations to build a better world. The program envisions and endeavors toward a just, peaceful, and civilized global society.

The courses offered in the program reflect this vision, and are structured along two main threads. First, the courses contain a set of studies on various objects related with international relations. Second, they also contain discussions about the way international relations are portrayed, and explore the views about how the future of international relations should be. To this end, students will not only be equipped with mere knowledge and skills, but also with a critical attitude toward the existing conditions in international relations, such as injustice, inequality, poverty, environmental degradation, and violence.

The program develops innovative and collaborative learning process in the class. It also promotes problem-solving oriented research, in addition to its mission to facilitate students oriented toward reflection, action, and emancipation.

Competence

1. Diplomacy

Provide students with the competence oriented toward future career potential in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and other diplomatic institutions, such as embassies and foreign missions.

2. Transnational Affairs

Provide students with the necessary knowledge and skills for pursuing career in international institutions and transnational corporations.

3. Research and Academia

Provide students with the knowledge and skills required for research and teaching profession in the field of international relations.

4. Journalism

Provide students with the capability to enter into journalistic and mass media world using the knowledge and skills on transnational and international affairs.

Focus of Study

To realize the vision of developing the generations who dare to inspire, the program designs a new curriculum focusing on three areas of study. They are as follow:

Topic-based Courses

1. Global Politics and Security

Global Politics and Security endeavors to explore issues, concepts, policies and theorization in the realms of diplomacy, foreign policy, international organization, international regime, and international law.

2. Peace and Conflict Studies

Peace and Conflict Studies delves deeper into the study of conflict and peace, enhancing the mastery of issues, practices, and theories of international peace, with the specific goal to understand peace process and operation.

3. International Political Economy and Development

International Political Economy and Development is designed to explore issues, concepts, and theories in the realms of international development and cooperation, global political economy, politics of trade and finance, business diplomacy, and global value chain.
