 minimum skor 300 (equivalent to ITP min. skor 543 and IELTS min. 5.0)
- Pass Gadjah Mada Scholastic Test (GMST) : min. skor 450
- **⊘** Pass Intake Test (Interview and Writing Test)

DUAL DEGREE

One of the most significant advantages of being admitted as a student at IUP FH UGM is the availability of a dual degree opportunity. This means the exceptional IUP students have the chance to obtain two bachelor degrees in law, one from UGM and one from the partner university abroad, without having to spend three to four extra years. In approximately four years successful candidates will have obtained a Sarjana Hukum degree from UGM and a Legum Baccalaureus (Bachelor of Laws/LL.B.) from a partner university.

At present there are two universities that students can choose to pursue a second degree:

- University of Groningen, the Netherlands.; and
- University of Maastricht, the Netherlands

However, the Faculty continuously develop partnership with prospective partners for a dual degree program, such as Durham University UK, UiTM Malaysia, and City University of Hong Kong.
